GOSHEN COMMON COUNCIL

Minutes for the Regular Meeting of March 7, 2017

The Common Council of the City of Goshen, Indiana met in a regular meeting on March 7, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. in the City Court Room/Council Chambers at the Goshen Police & Court Building, 111 East Jefferson Street, Goshen, IN. Presiding Officer was Mayor Stutsman, with members of the Council present or absent as follows:

CHANGES TO THE AGENDA

Mayor Stutsman removed the presentation by Mark Dobson for the EDC of Elkhart County from the Agenda. City Attorney Larry Barkes requested that Resolution #2017-07 be tabled. Mayor Stutsman corrected Agenda item #1 to reflect a First Reading of Ordinance #4895. Seeing no other changes to the Agenda, Mayor Stutsman called for a motion to approve the Agenda as amended. Motion made by Councilman Ahlersmeyer. Motion seconded by Council President McKee.

By a 7-0 unanimous vote the motion passed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mayor Stutsman called for a motion regarding the Minutes from November 1, November 15, December 6, December 20, and December 27, 2016. Motion made by Councilman Ahlersmeyer to accept the minutes from November 1, November 15, December 6, December 20, and December 27, 2016 as presented. Motion seconded by Councilman Orgill.

By a 7-0 unanimous vote the motion passed.

PRESENTATIONS

Scott Woldruff presented the Economic Improvement District 2016 Annual Report and requested permission to approve the EID 2016 Annual Report and the EID 2017 Budget at 7 minutes and 50 seconds of the audio recording. Mayor Stutsman called for a motion to accept the EID 216 Annual Report and the EID 2017 Budget. Motion made by Councilwoman Gautsche. Motion seconded by Councilman Ahlersmeyer.

By a 7-0 unanimous vote the motion passed.

ORDINANCE #4895

Council President McKee introduced Ordinance #4895 entitled "TREE REMOVAL ON PRIVATE PROPERTY."

Council President McKee asked the Clerk-Treasurer to read the Ordinance by title only for its first reading and moved for its passage. Motion seconded by Councilman Scharf.

Councilman Scharf moved to amend the Ordinance to include the following subsection:

(g)

- 1. If any tree branch on private property, by virtue of its position, size, and condition constitutes a clear and significant hazard to the safety of any person or constitutes a clear and significant hazard to any structure or other personal property, the clear and significant hazard must be eliminated by the property owner at the property owner's expense. An exception shall be made if the clear and significant hazard is to a structure or other personal property wholly owned by the same person who owns the tree.
- 2. Determination that a tree or tree branch constitutes a clear and significant hazard shall b made by the City of Goshen Forester or other similarly-qualified party.
- 3. Trees located on private property and not within the right-of-way shall not be subject to any formal inspection program administered by the City or its agents without the consent of the property owner.
- 4. If a tree or tree branch that poses a threat is located both on private property and within public right-of-way, the property owner may take advantage of the City of Goshen street tree removal program established under subsection (d).

Motion was seconded by Councilwoman Gautsche.

Council President McKee introduced Ordinance #4896 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 3011 KNOWN AS THE ZONING AND USE REGULATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF GOSHEN, INDIANA BY REZONING THE AREA OF REAL ESTATE HERINAFTER DESCRIBED FROM AGRICULTURAL A-1 TO COMMERCIAL B-3 WITH A PLANNED PUD OVERLAY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS THE TRULOCKS PUD."

Council President McKee asked the Clerk-Treasurer to read the Ordinance by title only for its first reading and moved for its passage. Motion seconded by Councilman Ahlersmeyer.

Planning and Zoning Administrator Rhonda Yoder outlined the scope of the Ordinance at 52 minutes and 11 seconds of the audio recording.
